- Buildings and Grounds (M. Tschomakoff)
  - Rodney and Margarita note that furnace repair is needed; during an annual check Hoffmann recommended repair to blower in HVAC system (\$745), this issue may have contributed to last year's high heating bills.
  - Front façade resurfacing complete; east wall gutter repair complete; work will begin on north wall plaster repair. No progress on parish hall ceiling which will start after sanctuary repairs are completed. Reminder that any work we have done must be bid out unless it is donated to us.
  - Expenses for Sanctuary window--replace plexiglass and repair bullet hole, \$1,962.00 with \$1000 deductible. Ann Balsamo moves to approve, Ronya seconds; vestry approval is unanimous.

#### • Budget (N. Emmel Gunn)

- Nothing out of the ordinary; deficit of \$5000 already; spent more money than brought in for January
- April quarterly report to congregation for transparency

#### • Priest's Update

- Nancy preparing parochial report which is due March 1 every year; the draft will soon be available for vestry comment and approval.
- For the first time the diocese has asked for demographic information age group and ethnicity; Nancy has used COVID sign in sheets to compile data; 78 people in 2022
- We are the youngest-trending church in diocese; we have sixteen kids under age 18; sixteen people over age 64 and the only parish in Missouri diocese with this age breakdown. Our congregation still is predominantly 5% people of color.
- Vestry retreat
- Nancy again elected as representative for Emery Washington convocation
- March 21-23 clergy retreat
